Nachtigal Project keeps on providing support to Ntui Technical High School

Wide-range equipment to meet the expectations of different departments of the school.

NHPC held on Tuesday, October 27, 2020 a handing-over of materials at the Technical High School of Ntui in the presence of Mr. Georges Marcel Mandoh, Mayor of Ntui, Mr. Jean-Claude Wouri, Divisional Delegate of Secondary Education, and Mr. Simon Grandet Yemeko, Headmaster of the Technical High School of Ntui.

Made in consultation with the school's management, this allocation, worth a total of nearly CFA F 20 million, responds to the needs of several departments of the Technical High School: social and family economy, childcare, home economics, clothing industry and computer science.

voltage regulators, computers, household electrical appliances, kitchen items, sewing machines, sliding headstocks, jigsaws, planers and grinders.

This action falls within the scope of a long-term and integrated strategy for sustaining secondary education..

This is not the first time NHPC is involved in an initiative in favor of Ntui Technical High School, which enrolls nearly 1,250 students. The establishment had already benefited in 2017 from the renovation and equipment of the workshop of its Civil Engineering department.

Moreover, other equipment orders are underway for the departments of Industrial Engineering, Sanitary Installation Engineering and Woodworking of the Technical High School of Ntui.

Besides, NHPC's commitment for secondary schools also cover the Technical High School of Mbandjock, the Technical High School of Obala, as well as the CETIC and the General High School of Batchenga.
